Job Specification:

Independent Living Skills Trainer (ILST) –

Candidates must be ILST certified or meet the qualifications to be certified having the minimum experience working with ABI individuals

ILST job duties consist of training in and supervision of daily living skills and socialization activities for individuals with acquired brain injuries who are living in community settings. This includes, but not limited to: training and assessment in self-care, medication management, task completion, communication and interpersonal skills, problem solving, and ability to maintain a household.

ILSTs can provide transportation to consumers when other viable community alternative is not provided. ILSTs may be required to communicate with community members, medical professionals, and the team members on the consumer's behalf.

Job requirements will also include being able to work independently, to follow and implement treatment plans, function as part of an interdisciplinary team, and keep accurate records.

ILSTs are required to complete daily household activity sheets and produce monthly reports for each consumer they service by the beginning of the next month of service. They are responsible for maintaining safety logs and incident reports. They are responsible for reporting to the house supervisor on a weekly basis.

All employees must have a valid Connecticut driver's license, as well as a clean driving record. All employees must also have access to a safe and reliable vehicle with proof of current registration and current insurance.

All employees must be able to lift 50 lbs or more several times a day if needed.
